- 1 The Royal opera of Stockholm / Gustav adolfs torg Visit the beautiful Royal opera, The Medieval Museum or just enjoy the view over the Royal Palace of Stockholm.
- 2 Old Town Southbound Take a walk around the Old town and enjoy its historical buildings, streets, cafés, museum and shops. Here you can also take a short walk to ourboat stop number 1.
