

Sights to explore

- Riddarhuset** – The Swedish House of Nobility is one of the most beautiful buildings in the city. Other sights near the stop include Riddarholmskyrkan and the Nobel Prize Museum.
- The Royal opera of Stockholm / Gustav adolfs torg** – Visit the beautiful Royal opera, The Medieval Museum or just enjoy the view over the Royal Palace of Stockholm.
- Old Town Southbound** – Take a walk around the Old town and enjoy its historical buildings, streets, cafés, museum and shops. Here you can also take a short walk to ourboat stop number 1.
- Southern Heights** – Probably the most spectacular view of Stockholm. From here take a short walk up the picturesque street Fjällgatan or walk down to Fotografiska.
- Medborgarplatsen** – This vibrant square is the biggest square in Stockholm, located in the heart of the trendy Södermalm area. On the square there are several different pubs and restaurants to enjoy.
- Old Town Northbound** – Take a walk around the Old town and enjoy its historical buildings, streets, cafés, museum and shops. Here you can also take a short walk to ourboat stop number 1.
- Kungsträdgården** – An oasis in the heart of Stockholm where you can enjoy many events in the summer and ice skating in the winter. During the springtime people will gather here to take pictures under the cherry blossom trees.
- Nybroplan** – Welcome to the upper-class area of Stockholm, Östermalm. Here you will find the Royal Dramatic Theatre and the exclusive shopping street Biblioteksgatan. A short walk from our stop is Stureplan, where you'll find fine dining locations and nightclubs.
- The Vasa Museum, Nordic Museum & Junibacken Southbound** – Visit the 17th century Vasa ship, The Nordic Museum and Junibacken - the museum of children's fairytales and theatre. Enjoy the great range of museums, attractions and the beautiful nature.
- Skansen Gröna Lund & ABBA The Museum** – Experience Skansen, the worlds oldest open-air museum, dance and sing along in ABBA The Museum or jump on the rides at the Tivoli - Gröna Lund.
- The Vasa Museum, Nordic Museum & Junibacken Northbound** – Visit the 17th century Vasa ship, The Nordic Museum and Junibacken - the museum of children's fairytales and theatre. Enjoy the great range of museums, attractions and the beautiful nature.
- Karlaplan** – Take a walk along the exclusive avenue Karlavägen and explore the wide range of restaurants and cafés. When you are in the neighbourhood, pay a visit to The National Historical Museum.
- Stureplan** – This is where you come in Stockholm for fine dining and night clubs
- Hard Rock Cafe** – Stockholm's Hard Rock Café opened in 1985. Welcome inside and soak up the rock history with some drinks and a nice meal. Across the street you can visit the Stockholm Public Library and the Observatorielunden.
- Hötorget/Concert Hall** – Step in to the world of music in the Concert Hall. Or enjoy the big range of shopping at the Hötorget market and the shops at the main shopping street Drottninggatan. For the adventurous, Paradox Museum is an exhilarating sensory experience situated next to Hötorget's subway station and a family favorite.
- ICEBAR & Central Station** – The ICEBAR is located inside the Nordic Hotel. A short walk from here you'll find Stockholm Central Station and Arlanda Express. Inside the central station you can visit our Tours & Tickets shop.
- City Terminalen** – Stockholms main bus terminal. Here you find buses to Arlanda Airport, Skavsta Airport, Bromma Airport and Västerås Airport.
- Rådhuset / Stockholm Court House** – Welcome to Kungsholmen, this vibrant part of Stockholm has many great restaurants, bars and cafés.
- Stadshuset - City Hall** – Host of the annual Nobel Prize banquet and well known for it's unique art treasures. In summer you can climb to the top of the tower for beautiful panoramic views.
